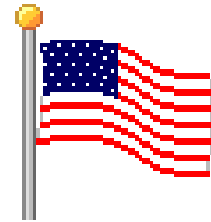

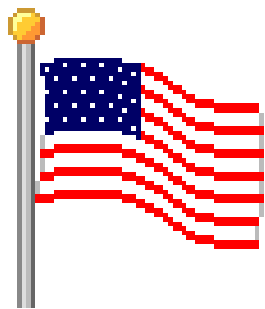
## Why do we celebrate Memorial Day?
