For the purposes of the state of emergency and evening curfew as declared by the Governor and Director of Public Health, you have been declared an **ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEE**. You are expected to work during a declared state of emergency unless your supervisor advises you otherwise.

**TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES:** Please note that the bearer of this notice has been designated an essential employee for the State of Ohio. Their presence at their worksite is essential to the operations of UCP of Greater Cleveland (addresses listed below). These locations are Medicaid-certified, state licensed facilities serving individuals with disabilities.

We respectfully request that all Law Enforcement Officials respect this essential employee status and extend all courtesies to this individual during periods of a state of emergency and curfew.
