



CAMP LEAFBRIDGE

Camp LeafBridge is an activity-based summer camp for students with significant physical and cognitive disabilities. This unique program offers high levels of support while addressing Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals through Extended School Year (ESY) services. Camp activities are planned and coordinated by specialists in the areas of special education, physical/occupational/speech therapies, and assistive technology. UCP will adhere to all CDC guidelines as well as social distancing guidelines for programming.

Camp LeafBridge promotes progress and minimizes loss of skills during the summer months for:

- Students with multiple and complex disabilities
- Students who require low or 1:1 staff to student ratios
- Students with newly emerging skills
- Students with excessive absences during the school year
- Students who require highly skilled assistive technology services

Common goal areas addressed in Camp LeafBridge:

- Communication
- Social skills
- Self-Care
- Mobility
- Power-mobility
- Pre-vocational skills
- Assistive technology skills for daily living, computer access, augmentative and alternative communication, environmental control, impaired vision, mobility aids, recreational and educational technology
- Leisure skills such as swimming, sensory, yoga and community field trips
- Transition skills
