LeafBridge works together with local school districts to help determine the optimal environment and services to meet each student's needs and maximize their opportunity for development. Through these partnerships, LeafBridge seeks to elevate the standards of education for students with multiple and complex disabilities. LeafBridge offers an on-site Alternative Education Program in Brooklyn Heights with half and full day options available. We also offer various summer programs, including Extended School Year and Summer Camp.
